THE SHED IS NOT THE TIP

We do not want furniture, TVs, kitchen appliances, timber etc...no matter how good it is. With anything else, approval of the committee is required PRIOR to bringing it on site.

With prior consultation some items maybe accepted ie. the boat, trailer and BBQ as these were seen as providing work for members and upon completion could result in producing a direct benefit to the shed either through public relations, sale of the items or our usage.

LADDERS

There is a lot of ladder work being carried out at the shed at moment, all aimed at getting the emergency lighting and exit signage installed. As commendable as this is, too many risks are being taken. **ALL LADDERS** (when in use) **MUST BE "FOOTED" OR TIRED OFF** and used at the appropriate angle. I found one the other day set at an angle more appropriate for a set of stairs!!!! This is just madness and could be deadly. Over the past 5 years we have had a very good safety record with only one reported incident. Let's think SAFETY FIRST for everything we do.

LAWN MOWERING

Thanks to NEMO, our next door neighbour for slashing the top paddock when we returned to Simeon Road after Christmas. The grass hadn't been cut for 3-4 weeks and was a jungle. The following week was when we had the reported incident (as noted above). The mower was being operated without the catcher attached and the back guard tired off in the open position (to prevent clogging of 10 words a woman uses.

(9) <u>Don't worry</u> about it, I got it:
